1. Discussion of SB 1070 projects and ideas
 - a. 1070 Funds can now be spent.
 - b. Ideas to spend 1070 Funds:
 - i. Cannot use 1070 funds on:
 1. RN Transition programs with unpaid externships.
 2. Brief phlebotomy skills update/Nurses returning to field or new grads, IV therapy skills update, incumbent workers/Intubations update for EMTs Paramedics. Quick skills update courses not allowed because focus need to be on k12
 3. COE purchase a database for labor market needs

 - iii. Starla A. Ewan workshop series
 - iv. More professional development workshops – with H.S. instructors
 - v. MARY
 1. Bring faculty together from high schools, ROP and community colleges to standardize medical terminology
 2. Faculty development, job shadowing for high school and middle school teachers. Various departments in hospitals to better contextualize in the classroom
 3. Employer-faculty meeting; employers to share with faculty what they are looking for in regards to soft skills.
