Associate Vice Chancellor- Academic Programs, Innovations and Faculty Development California State University Office of the Chancellor

- Purpose- To develop and support partnerships between the two public education systems in effort to improve nursing education
- CCC-CSU make up the largest contributors to he nursing workforce in the state
- Public nursing education faces unique challenges and provide unique opportunities

- Challenges in the past have been amplified by COVID-19
 - OClinical facilities have largely shut students out or posed barriers
 - Ourriculum has caused changes to become overdue
 - Regulators and policies have caused unnecessary burdens to nursing education overall
