- Notice of Proposed Action to amend section 1107 & 1109 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (<u>HWI Blog</u>)
 - RDH Course in Periodontal Soft Tissue Curettage, Local Anesthesia, and Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen Analgesia (SLN)
 - Task force the CC were included
 - Part of the DH Practice Act
 - Programs Directors are in favor
 - Approval of Curriculum Requirements for Radiographic Decision-Making and Interim Therapeutic Restoration Courses for the Registered Dental Hygienist (RDH), Registered Dental Hygienist in Alternative Practice (RDHAP) and Registered Dental Hygienist in Extended Functions (RDHEF)
 - Santa Rosa is approved and will continue to be okay
