








Class Key




Learner Enters Class Key - 1

Host a Zoom meeting: Target speaking practice around topics and vocabulary covered in the lesson (from the course's Scope & Sequence). Log into the learner site and show your screen.

Remote Learning Ideas

Students upload screenshots: The teacher can create an assignment (e.g. "Complete Unit 1") in their LMS. Students can upload a picture of their score(s) into the LMS to show completion.
